

## ASPEN/ASPE 2017 SPRING TOPICAL MEETING

### **POSTER SESSION PRESENTATION GUIDELINES**

- ❖ Presentation of a poster provides an opportunity for effective one-to-one communication. Poster papers are expected to adhere to the same high standards as oral presentation papers. That is, they should contain significant technical results and data together with their interpretation without commercialism. A good format to follow is 1) a brief introduction 2) experimental detail, if novel 3) results 4) conclusion.
- ❖ The Poster Sessions will be held on **Thursday, March 16 from 2:00 to 3:15 p.m.** Presenters should be present during the poster session hours to present their papers. All posters should be removed after the end of the Session at 3:15 PM.
- ❖ A poster board will be provided in the poster presentation area. The board's segments has a size of 100cm (wide) x 250cm (High) (Please refer to the below figure). Your poster must be designed to fit within the confines of this.
- ❖ For best results, use a laser type printer or photo-typesetter. Double-spacing is best for ease in reading, and nothing less than 16 pt. type should be used.
- ❖ Horizontal posters will not fit the boards. Plotter-created posters of a size larger than 100cm (wide) x 250cm (High) will not be accepted.
- ❖ A 100cm (wide) x 250cm (High) printed title panel, including the name of the authors, will be provided by ASPE for the top of the poster panel. Title and authors shall be listed exactly as shown on the extended abstract.
